

## CONSENT TO THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

This Consent to the Processing of Personal Data ("Consent") records the free, informed, and unequivocal manifestation of the Data Subject, whereby the Data Subject agrees to the processing of their personal data for the specific purposes described herein, in accordance with Brazilian Federal Law No. 13,709/2018 (the Brazilian General Data Protection Law – "LGPD").

By accepting this Consent, the Data Subject acknowledges and agrees that ABTCP – Brazilian Technical Association of Pulp and Paper ("NOTIFYING PARTY"), a legal entity enrolled under CNPJ No. 62.259.279/0001-79, with registered offices at Rua Joaquim Floriano, 466, Corporate Building, 8th Floor, Itaim Bibi, São Paulo, SP, Brazil, acting as the Data Controller ("Controller"), may make decisions regarding the processing of the Data Subject's personal data and perform processing activities including, without limitation, the collection, production, receipt, classification, use, access, reproduction, transmission, distribution, processing, filing, storage, deletion, evaluation, control, modification, communication, transfer, dissemination and extraction of personal data.

Acceptance of this Consent authorizes the collection and processing of personal data for the following purposes:

- I. To enable the Controller to maintain participant records for courses, lectures, seminars and monthly meetings;
- II. To enable the Controller to identify and contact the Data Subject for institutional and professional relationship purposes;
- III. To enable the Controller to prepare and execute commercial agreements with service providers;
- IV. To enable the Controller to promote and offer its institutional products and services, whether free of charge or for consideration;
- V. To enable the Controller to conduct surveys and research related to its institutional purposes.

### DATA SHARING

The Controller is authorized to share the Data Subject's personal data with other data processing agents whenever necessary to achieve the purposes described herein, always in compliance with the principles and safeguards established by the LGPD.

### DATA SECURITY

The Controller shall maintain appropriate technical and organizational security measures designed to protect personal data against unauthorized access and against accidental or unlawful destruction, loss, alteration, disclosure, or any other unlawful or improper processing.

Pursuant to Article 48 of the LGPD, the Controller shall notify the Data Subject and the Brazilian National Data Protection Authority (ANPD) of any security incident that may result in a material risk or damage to the Data Subject.

#### RETENTION OF PERSONAL DATA

The Controller may retain and process the Data Subject's personal data for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes set forth in this Consent. Anonymized data that can no longer be associated with an identifiable individual may be retained indefinitely.

The Data Subject may request, at any time, by email or written correspondence, the deletion of non-anonymized personal data. The Data Subject acknowledges that such deletion may prevent the Controller from continuing to provide certain products or services.

#### RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT

At any time and upon request, the Data Subject shall have the right to obtain from the Controller:

- Confirmation of the existence of data processing;
- Access to personal data;
- Correction of incomplete, inaccurate, or outdated personal data;
- Anonymization, blocking, or deletion of unnecessary, excessive, or unlawfully processed data;
- Data portability, subject to applicable legal requirements;
- Deletion of personal data processed based on consent, except where retention is legally permitted;
- Information regarding public and private entities with which personal data has been shared;
- Information regarding the possibility of refusing consent and the consequences thereof;
- Withdrawal of consent, pursuant to Article 8, Paragraph 5 of the LGPD.

#### RIGHT TO WITHDRAW CONSENT

This Consent may be withdrawn by the Data Subject at any time by written request submitted via email or other written communication to the Controller.
